We will store the information you volunteer securely for the lifetime of the project and in accordance with appropriate data protection protocols. Please only enter business related information.

The supplier registration form is not a qualification system. Completing the form does not mean that your organisation has been qualified to work with Llŷr Wind.

Cookie Policy

What are cookies?

Most websites use cookies. A cookie is a small text file that a website sends to your computer or mobile device. When you visit a site again, the cookie is sent back to the website.
